Every year, we ask God to move in some large ways for our church planting ministry. We call these large requests "mountains" as we reference Matthew 17: 20, "I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

Believing that statement, here are the "BIG" things we are asking the Father to move ahead of us during 2019:

- **1. Plant 5 churches in Chicagoland:** We are specifically praying that we start two in urban areas and two in suburban areas (and trusting God to lead us to where #5 will be);
- **2. Partner with 3 plants outside Chicagoland:** We are currently working with Heartland Evangelizing Association to help with the Highland, IL plant in fall 2019 and are praying for two other opportunities to partner in planting;
- **3. Identify 20 church planters for Ignite's pipeline:** We continue to pray that God brings us workers for the harvest. Specifically, we are praying for one planter to come to us from each of the four people groups identified in Chicagoland;
- **4. Raise up 100 new individual donors for Ignite:** Here is where we want to be praying for Jared Mehrle as he helps develop more partners for our ministry;
- **5. Develop a matching fund for planting:** In August, we will be receiving \$100,000 for church planting. We want to match that with another \$100,000 that will provide the funding for at least four churches:
- **6. Multiplication for the future:** We have several different initiatives that will begin this year the Parent Church Network, Freelance Planter Academy (for training non-traditional church planters), along with several opportunities for the development of other "arms" of Ignite that can be of benefit to the Kingdom.
- **7. Open to surprises from the Father:** God surprised us several times during 2018 in exciting ways, we want to pray for open eyes and hearts to respond to surprises this year.
